MoU 2013-2014

REIL has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), for the year 2013-14, with Department of Heavy Industry, Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises, Government of India, on 25th March 2013.

FINANCIAL RESULTS: FY 2012-2013

The unaudited results of FY 2012-2013 are now available. The Company has recorded a turnover of Rs. 243 Crore against the target of Rs. 195 Crore. The Electronics Division achieved a turnover of Rs. 70 Crore. The Renewable Energy Division achieved a record turnover of Rs. 173 Crore.

PERFORMANCE : Q4 FY 2012-13

The fourth quarter of the Company closed on 31st March 2013. During this quarter, the Company has clocked a turnover of Rs. 31.99 Crore. The Electronics Division achieved a turnover of Rs 20.89 Crore while Renewable Energy Division achieved a turnover of Rs 11.10 Crore.

Achievements: Electronics Division

During this period, the Company expanded its area of business and received major orders for AMCU from Punjab, Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan, Bihar and DPMCU from Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra & Karnataka. The Company has also received orders for Electronic Milk Tester from Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra; Milk Analyzer from Kerala, Punjab, Tamil Nadu.

During this quarter the division has supplied sizable number of various Milk testing and collection units i.e Electronic Milk Testers, DPMCU, Smart-DPMCU, AMCU etc.

Achievements: Renewable Energy Division

During this quarter, the Division has supplied Solar Power Plants of various capacities in the state of Kerala and Manipur. The Company has received order for supply and installation of Solar Power Plants for Government PG collage, Jaipur. In this quarter the Company has executed an order of SPV Power Packs in Government schools for fulfillment of critical power needs in creation of National Optical Fiber Network (NOFN), in its home state.

The Company had kept its promise to contribute in development of the state by supply and installation of sizable numbers of SPV Home Lighting Systems under Rural Electrification (RE) programme. The Company has also supplied and installed SPV Street Lighting Systems at various sites during this period.

INNOVATION AT REIL

There was a need for a stand alone unit which is capable to work as independent milk procurement & payment system at village milk cooperative societies. An upgraded advance version of Data Processor Unit, based on ATMEGA processor was developed. It is capable of handling & storing data for over a year through enhanced memory with data portability. The system works in real time mode.

The Data Processor Unit receives Milk Fat, SNF and weight data from the respective electronic equipment interfaced with it. In addition to conventional milk transaction by milk producers, it also supports the Milk Producers Institute's milk

transaction. The instrument has option for manual entry of milk Fat, SNF, weight and personalization data through keyboard. A specially designed serial pen drive is being used for downloading the data for processing of milk transitions at Bulk Milk Cooler Center/Milk Plant.
