# PERFORMANCE: Q1 FY 2014-15

The first quarter of the FY 2014-15 closed on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014. At the end of first quarter, the Company turnover stood at Rs. 25.16 Crore. The Renewable Energy Division and Electronics Division turnover stood at Rs. 10.64 Crore and Rs. 14.52 Crore respectively.

The Turnover is increased by 20% over the corresponding period turnover of Rs. 20.93 Crore.

#### Achievements: Electronics Division

During this quarter, the Division has supplied sizable quantities of various Milk testing and collection units i.e. Electronic Milk Testers, DPMCU, Smart-DPMCU, AMCU etc.

The Company received major orders for AMCU and DPMCU from Haryana, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Gujarat, Rajasthan, MP, and Maharashtra etc. It also received large orders for these products, under the National Dairy Plan (NDP), from various states.

Apart from these, REIL also received large orders for DPU based MCU from Rajasthan; EMAT; Auto EMT based AMCU from Gujarat and Solar-EMT from Bihar.

# **Customer Training Program**

REIL conducted training sessions for its customers at various locations across the country. Training was imparted to about 65 end-users of EMT in Gujarat; to the DPMCU users in Rajasthan and Gujarat in different milk plants.

#### **Product Demonstration**

The recently developed Electronic Milk Adulteration Tester (EMAT) was demonstrated at VERKA milk plant — Patiala, Hoshiarpur, Jalandhar under MILKFED, Punjab and VITA Milk Plant Ambala, Jind, Rothak under HDDCF, Panchkula during this quarter.

# Achievements: Renewable Energy Division

During the quarter, the Division has executed some prestigious orders, for customers such as BREDA, RITES Ltd., and Rural Development Department Uttar Pradesh.

In the state of Rajasthan, the Company has supplied and installed SPV Power Plants at Science Centres in Kota and Jhalawar, under Department of Science & Technology. The Company also executed orders for Department of Watershed in the state

In the Eastern Region, the Company executed orders for Solar Water Pumping systems in the state of Bihar, under BREDA and also undertook installation of SPV Submersible Pumps in the state of Madhya Pradesh.

Against the orders from RITES Limited, the Company has supplied SPV Power Plants for various buildings of Institutional Campus at Rohtak during the quarter.

The Company has also provided SPV home-lighting solutions for various houses, under the ambitious project of Rural Development Department of Uttar Pradesh for Lohiya Gramin Awas Yojana.

During the quarter, Company has exported more than 1000 nos. of SPV Systems including Home Lighting Systems & Lanterns, against order from a customer in Norway. These systems are installed in remote and far flung villages for upliftment of rural masses.
