### MOU FOR SETTING UP 4,000 MW ULTRA MEGA SOLAR POWER PROJECT

REIL joined fellow Public Sector Enterprises namely Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL), Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) Hindustan Salts Limited (SSL), Power Grid Corporation of India



Limited (POWERGRID), and SJVN Limited to sign the MoU for formation of Joint Venture Company for setting up of 4,000 MW Ultra Mega Solar Power Project at Sambhar, Rajasthan, in the august presence of Shri Praful Patel, Hon'ble Union Minister for Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises and Dr. Farooq Abdullah, Hon'ble Union Minister for New and Renewable Energy, on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2014.

# PERFORMANCE MOURATING FOR THE FY 2012-13

The Company has been awarded an Excellent rating by the Department of Public Enterprises, MHI&PE, GoI, for its performance as per MoU for the FY 2012-13. REIL is the only company under DHI (Department of Heavy Industry) to achieve Excellent rating for FY 2012-13.

# MoU with CONCOR for CSR & Sustainable development

REIL signed a MoU with CONCOR for supply, installation & commissioning of a Solar Photo Voltaic Power Plant at their Inland Container Depot (ICD), Kanakpura, Jaipur, under their environment-sustainability initiative, in line with the CSR and



sustainable guidelines of the DPE. This system will address the lighting needs even in case of power outage and also promote use of Renewable Energy for conservation and restoration of eco-system through reduction of carbon emissions.

### PERFORMANCE: Q4 FY 2013-14

The Fourth quarter of the Company closed on 31st March 2014. At the end of fourth quarter, the Company turnover stood at Rs. 216.16. Crore. The turnover of Renewable Energy Division and Electronics Division stood at Rs. 127.31 Crore and Rs. 88.85 Crore respectively.

During this quarter, the Company has clocked a turnover of Rs. 124.31 Crore. The Electronics Division achieved a turnover of Rs. 37.21 Crore while Renewable Energy Division achieved a turnover of Rs. 87.10 Crore.

### Achievements: Electronics Division

During this quarter the Division has supplied sizable numbers of various milk testing and collection units, namely Electronic Milk Testers, DPMCU, Smart-DPMCU, AMCU etc.

REIL "Shaping Rural India through Electronics, Renewable Energy and 17 Solutions".

The Company received major orders for EMT from Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra; Milk Analyzer from Tamil Nadu, Rajasthan (NGC), Madhya Pradesh; and RMRD from Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Punjab.

It received major orders for AMCU and DPMCU from Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, and Rajasthan. It also received large orders for these products, under the National Dairy Plan (NDP), from various states.

Apart from these, REIL also received a large order for Solar-EMT from Bihar, and orders for DPMCU from Haryana and Rajasthan.

### **Customer Training Program**

REIL conducted training sessions for its customers at various locations across the country. Training was imparted to about 250 end-users of EMT in Gujarat; to the DPMCU users under Katraj Dairy, Pune; and to the users of AMCS under the Gokul Dairy, Kolhapur.

# Achievements: Renewable Energy Division

During this quarter, the Division executed some prestigious orders, for customers such as GAIL (India) Ltd., CONCOR, Assam Rifles, Rural Development Department, Govt. of UP, Department of Horticulture, Govt. of Rajasthan, and KELTRON.

REIL has undertaken supply and installation of SPV systems, to various PSUs, for addressing requirements under their CSR activity. REIL has further supplied GAIL (India) Ltd substantial quantity of SPV Street Lighting Systems and installed them in various districts of U.P. Similarly, under a MOU with Container Corporation of India, REIL has undertaken design, supply and installation of a SPV Power Plant for their ICD, Kanakpura, Jaipur, under their CSR & sustainable development activity.

The Company has also supplied and installed large number of SPV Water Pumping Systems under scheme of Department of Horticulture, Govt. of Rajasthan, during the quarter.

The Company further consolidated its presence in the Southern Region and executed an order for a Grid Interactive SPV Power Plant at Kozhikode (Kerala), apart from execution of other orders for SPV Power Plants in Kerala.

In the Eastern Region Company executed orders for SPV Power Plants in Assam and undertook installation of SPV Pumps in Bihar.

Under the SECI scheme also, the Company has supplied and commissioned SPV Power Plants, during the quarter.

The Company has also provided SPV home-lighting solutions to more than 13000 nos. houses under the ambitious project of Rural Development Department of UP for Lohiya Gramin Awas Yojana.

During the quarter, the Company has exported 1260 nos. of Solar Home Lighting Systems to Afghanistan.

### NEW PRODUCTS

### Home Lighting Solution for Rural Housing

The Company has also configured home lighting system which can be put to use in a small house, where the grid electricity is not available.

This system comprises 120 Wp capacity modules, one 5W LED light, 2 nos. 3W LED Light, one BLDC fan, one charge controller with charging socket for mobile and one battery 12V,100AH.

The LED Light with lower energy consumption and high lumen output serve to economize on the SPV system configuration.





This lighting system is useful for the economically weaker section of the society who can not afford a monthly electricity bill with a minimum charges value.

Instead such a system if provided as a one time grant can easily serve the need of a poor family over a period of 5-6 years, during which they can utilize time after sunset hours in a productive manner to augment their incomes and socio-economic level.

Higher capacity configuration can also be worked out depending upon the affordability of the customer.
