

PERFORMANCE : Q2 FY 2016-17

The Company has recorded a turnover of Rs. 103.40 Crore at the end of second quarter. The Renewable Energy achieved a turnover of Rs. 59.90 Crore while Electronics Division's turnover stood at Rs. 43.50 Crore.

The turnover and order booking has increased by 15% and 16% respectively over the corresponding year data.

Achievements : Electronics Division

During the quarter, the Company has received major orders of DPMCU/SPV DPMCU and AMCU from milk cooperatives of Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, Punjab and Kerala.

National Milk Grid and Cold Chain is critical need and REIL is gearing up to deploy GPRS enabled solutions across the country across the value chain in dairy co-operatives.



GPRS enabled solutions for Dairy Cooperatives

This real-time solution is aimed to ensure corruption free dairying by delivering more transparent information sharing solution for higher growth in dairy sector hence benefiting all stakeholders. The orders for 380 nos. GPRS based DPMCU have been received from milk unions of Rajasthan and Maharashtra.

Under the joint initiatives of Government of India and Government of Maharashtra for the drought prone area-Vidarbha, REIL will deploy more than 250 nos.-Data processor Milk Collection Units and Automatic Milk Collection Units in villages, for upliftment of rural masses.

The Company have embarked upon the challenging task in surpassing the previous EMAT orders and received new orders for EMAT from Rajasthan, Gujarat, Uttarakhand and Madhya Pradesh. Auto-EMT is another product which is capturing the market with the orders of 157 nos. received from Jammu & Kashmir, Gujarat and Karnataka. In line with providing Green solutions for dairy, the division has deployed 2.5 KW Solar Power plant in Jammu Dairy.

Apart from this, the Company continued receiving business for its regular products- EMTs, AMCUs and DPMCU. The deployment of approximately 2000 AMCU /DPMCU systems will benefit 1,00,000 milk producers of about equivalent villages of Punjab, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat.

Taking IT initiatives further to enhance transparency and bring more comfort in it's ongoing project with Rajasthan State Open School (RSOS), the Company has successfully integrated the web based on-line registration of student application software with payment gateway, where the registered students fill their registration forms and can deposit their fees online through e-mitra payment gateway.

The Division has setup the processing center at its premises and started the Digitization and Indexing work of approximately 7.5 Lac photo negatives (Black & White and Color) against the order received from Department of Information and Public Relations (DIPR), Government of Rajasthan.

As State Level Agency for the Election Department, Government of Rajasthan, the IT Division has successfully integrated the Electoral roll data of 4.37 Crore voters of Rajasthan state and implemented the online Electoral Roll Management Software for 200 assembly constituencies of the state.

Customer Training Program

The Company has imparted 760 mandays training in Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Punjab, Haryana, Gujrat and Maharashtra.

Achievements: Renewable Energy Division

During this quarter, the the division has executed various prestigious orders for Customers including POWERGRID, Container Corporation of India Ltd. and UPNEDA.

Under rooftop segment, the Company bagged a large-size order from Bihar Renewable Energy Development Authority (BREDA) for supply, installation and commissioning of 3.6 MW Rooftop Solar off Grid Power Plants spread over 3600 locations each of 1 KW in Bihar, to cater the energy needs of the domestic sector.

It is worth mentioning that under the Government of India vision of making Andaman & Nicobar Islands Diesel-free in respect of power generation, the Company has entered into a tripartite MoU with MNRE, Government of India and Andaman & Nicobar Administration to install Grid tied Solar Photovoltaic Power Plants with storage of 5 MW capacity, in three islands of Andaman & Nicobar.

These plants shall usher in a replacement to the Diesel-based Generating Sets, resulting in elimination of polluting smoke and create a carbon free environment. This initiation will reduce pollution and assist in preserving the ecological environment of these Islands.

Under Smart Cities Mission of Government of India, REIL has been already working as nodal agency for the cities- Jaipur and Udaipur, and has now received another opportunity to work as nodal agency for recently sanctioned cities- Kota and Ajmer, of Rajasthan, for setting up of Grid Connected Solar Power Plants on various government buildings.

In MW-Size business, the Company has installed at 1 MW Solar Power plant at Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) Refinery at Panipat. The plant is installed on 10 buildings at the campus and will generate about 1.25 Lac units every month.

The Company has been actively working under PSU CSR initiatives, and a variety of SPV applications such as 25 kWp SPV Power Plant at Railway Station and LED Street Lighting Systems (2000 nos.) in far flung areas of Uttar Pradesh have been deployed. The power plant is catering to the part load of the Railway station by working in parallel with the utility grid.

New Project

The Company has taken initiative towards a long pending need for online solution for the Transport Department, Government of Rajasthan, aligning it with Climate Change initiatives of the Government to help the environment by reduction in green house gases from vehicles which is the main cause of Global warming, and adversely effects human health.

REIL has received LoI from the department, for Networking of about 800 authorized Pollution Check Centres across the state. This will connect the centers to the centralized server making the entire process online and accordingly the Identification of the PUC certificates (current/due) could be obtained on real time basis.

At present only 10% vehicles go for pollution check out of 1 crore registered vehicles in the state. Once successfully implemented, this online solution will make the entire process transparent hence covering 100% vehicles, and protecting the Climate from harmful vehicle emissions.

In the area of Energy Efficiency & Energy Management, REIL being Project Management Consultant (PMC) has covered about 36854 nos. LED lights in last 6 months and overall 2.2 Lac LED lights have been deployed till date.

REIL declared 41% dividend to its Share Holders for the year 2015-16, in its 34th Annual General Meeting held on 19th September, 2016. The dividend declared is highest ever dividend to shareholders and is doubled as compared to previous year's dividend.

It was informed to the stakeholders that the Net Worth of the of the Company has crossed three digit with an increase by 7% from Rs. 94.44 Crore to Rs. 101.37 Crore and the Company has earned a Profit Before Tax (PBT) of Rs. 17.46 Crore on a turnover of Rs. 213.42 Crore.
